SOLICITORS REPORT: Jeff S. Shank, Solicitor

Regarding Northumberland County Attorneys had filed an appeal and no final order has been approved yet at this time still in a holding pattern. Judy Moser asked for explanation. Jeff reports that a lot of different directions that this appeal can go. Jeff feels that at the most the injunction filed by the Attorney's making these appeals have the good of all and great experience and expertise to help with this matter. There were a lot of procedural things that are happening until there would be a permanent evidentiary hearing in Commons' Pleas Court. Will keep us informed and Patty Streams-Warman will follow the appeals as this case continues.

COMMUNICATION REPORT: Judy Moser reported about Jury Commissioners. Shocked to hear that the President Judge had heard a report that there might be an investigation conducted and immediately locked the jury commissioners out of their office and said someone else would replace them to complete the term. A jury commissioner had on demand summons and this instigated a decision to lock out the Jury commissioners. Looking at the possibility of law suits to follow. Some things have not been confirmed as actual at this time until the investigation is completed.

BY-LAWS REPORT: Steve Lukah

Request by Rob Green York County, Vice President of PSAECO has asked that we amend the by-laws for the executive directors to vote if the elected member of that association is not present. We will have discussion on this matter but cannot be voted on for thirty days and would need to be brought up at the February meeting for a vote.

Rob Green explains that for example Bob Whitcomb Sheriff was a lone ranger (is that anything like John Wayne) and would be present but no other sheriff would be present so therefore unable to vote. Two thoughts would be to either have the association position on record or to allow that person appointed by the association to have a vote. Seeking a fair compromise for this situation.

Don Pertrille Jr. Registrar of Bucks County. We may need to look at the definitions of delegates according to the by-laws.

Bob Wollyung asked if the association would be required to put into writing to PSAECO who would be permitted to have a vote.

Rob, Steve and Don had several thoughts on the by-laws and how to proceed. Everyone does feel that something should be in writing as discussed. Association can appoint anyone to represent them but in order for a vote to be cast it must be an Elected Official. Steve read the law for definition of a delegate. By laws would allow the delegate to cast a vote if their association appointed them to do so and that would have to be submitted in writing.

Jeffrey Shank Solicitor would like to see something in writing that everyone could look out. Steve will get something out to everyone prior to February meeting.
